DWC's dual flush toilet and rain barrel displays were present. About 10 informational pamphlets about toilet leaks, lawncare, indoor/outdoor water use, a water quiz were handed out. Around 10 5-minute shower timers, 15 rain gauges, and 5 toilet leak detection tablets were distributed.
