The display from the Commission as well as other Earth-friendly displays was set up so the Argonne employees could peruse through the displays on the way into the cafeteria.

Around 50 informational pamphlets about toilet leaks, lawncare, indoor/outdoor water use, and a water quiz were handed out; about 80 5-minute shower timers; 200 rain gauges; and 100 toilet leak detection tablets were distributed. Many people were excited to see rain gauges and shower timers were developed and thought that these products were great ways to save water.
