#### **Coordinating Engineer**

The DuPage Water Commission, operator of the second largest waterworks system in Illinois, is seeking a full-time, Coordinating Engineer to perform technical engineering work for the planning, design and monitoring of construction on infrastructure and building projects, or functions as a project manager for major engineering projects of considerable scopes and complexities. Under the supervision of the General Manager, the engineer will perform professional engineering work in connection with design, installation, operations, maintenance of the Commission's facilities and pipelines throughout DuPage County. Day shift Monday thru Friday.

The qualified candidate for the Coordinating Engineer shall possess a Bachelor's degree in Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, or a directly related field of engineering from an accredited college or university. Water industry experience is desirable. The candidate should be able to apply basic engineering principles and theories to municipal development projects. The candidate should have a strong background working with computers and computer programs and able to use computer aided design software. The candidate should be physically fit to be able to access work sites during various stages of construction or repair. The work conditions will include general office environment, as well as, some occasional exposure to inclement weather and extreme temperatures.
