



DuPage Water Commission Attends Cantigny's Fourth Annual Green Fair

On Saturday, September 22, DuPage Water Commission Water Preservation Group Member Jenessa Rodriguez was in attendance for Cantigny's Fourth Annual Green Fair from 10am-4pm. Rain gauges, leak detection tablets, 5 minute shower timers and a variety of pamphlets educating the public on how to better use water so it is not wasted were handed out. The pamphlets included titles such as Outdoor/Indoor Water Use, Rain Barrel Information, How to Fix a Toilet Leak, Lawn Care, and How Much Water Do You Use?

DWC's life-size rain barrel display complete with siding and gutters as well as the dual flush toilet display were both present. Around 50 informational pamphlets about toilet leaks, lawncare, indoor/outdoor water use, and a water quiz were handed out. About 70 5-minute shower timers, 80 rain gauges, and 50 toilet leak detection tablets were given out.

Other activities besides vendor/information booths were green farms, eco-activities for kids, a local and organic Farmers Market, cooking demos, live music, recycling extravaganza, a FashionEcoNista Show and a Recycled Art Contest for high school and college students with cash prizes and much much more. The event drew a crowd of approximately 3,000 during the day's activities.
