



Notice of changed format of the Board Meeting for the DuPage Water Commission scheduled for June 18, 2020 due to COVID-19 pandemic

June 16, 2020

Governor JB Pritzker's Executive Order requiring shelter in place and prohibiting public gatherings means that the DuPage Water Commission's Board Meeting occurring on June 18, 2020 will take place **electronically**.

Both Executive Order 2020-07 (extended through June 27 by Executive Order 2020-39) as well as Illinois Attorney General Guidance to Public Bodies on the Open Meetings Act and the Freedom of Information Act during the COVID-19 Pandemic allow for public bodies to hold public meetings electronically to prevent the transmission of COVID-19.

It is strongly encouraged that you submit any comments in writing for the June 18, 2020 Commission's board meeting, and your comment will be read into the record at the Board meeting. Comments should be emailed to admin@dpwc.org. The DuPage Water Commission location at 600 E Butterfield Road in Elmhurst will be closed to the public.
